are met by the samples coated with the adhesive grade for the purpose described.

Thus, the adhesive **AP1000** according to the sample material submitted may be used safely for the reverse coating of labels. The adhesive layer of this may stand in direct contact with dry, moist and fatty foodstuffs. Furthermore, the adhesive may be used for laminating various materials. In this case, the seams may safely come into direct contact with foodstuffs.
